What Are the Eligibility Requirements?

While SCE will help you along the way, in order to participate in the program, your business must be an SCE customer and will be required to:

1. Lease, purchase, or convert at least two medium- or heavy-duty battery-powered EVs.
2. Own or lease the property where chargers are installed, and operate and maintain chargers for a minimum of 10 years.
3. Select, purchase, and install SCE-approved charging equipment.
4. Provide data related to charging equipment usage for a minimum of five years (on-road vehicles only).
5. Provide a property easement for the SCE infrastructure.
6. Agree to program terms and conditions.
